

Firstly on to some important information; just a reminder that nomination fees will now be \$50 for Seniors and Juniors, \$40 for Midgets and Rookies, 2nd nomination will be \$30.

We would like to remind all members that MEMBERSHIP FEES were DUE at the END OF February. Also, a reminder that all members are to obey track rules: only seniors are to practice together, all Juniors go together and midgets and rookies are together. Covered shoes are to be worn at all times, there is no smoking in the pits, only in the allocated smoking area.

Now down to racing.....

And what a weekend of racing it was. With this being the 1st of our big title meets this year, it was a great turn out with 129 starters. It was good to see some clear sky's and fast times all weekend and also good to see some out of towners at the track to get some practice for the State titles in July. It was also good to see a good crowd watching all the action over the weekend. It was good to see some big fields across most of the classes.

Midgets

With a field of 13 starters, it was the out of towners who showed some class. They were pushed all the way by local driver Declan Fraser, but it was a win to Quintin Slabbert (WKC) who showed the class by improving across the weekend to take the win from Declan Bloye (TKC) 2nd, 3rd was Brock Owen (RKC) and Declan Fraser (Mky) was 4th.

Rookies

A field of 7 karters, it was the Mackay boys who showed their class across the 3 rounds and come the final it went the way of the Mackay boys with a win to Jordan McGregor, 2nd was Jake Downs and 3rd went to Connor Smith(GKC).

Junior National Light

A good field of 8 starters, with a good battle across the whole field. It was a great battle between Jordan Page (GKC) and Joshua Smith (TKC) and Hayden Schneider across the weekend. But it was Jordan who took the win from Joshua 2nd, Hayden was 3rd and Roland Legge was 4th.



Senior National Heavy

With a great field of 18 and the biggest for the meet. There was some great racing done across the 2 days and come the final Justin Garioch showed some class and drove away from the field as he had done in the 2nd heat and pre final to take the win. The minor places were fought out between Jarryd Ebzery, Luke Caputo and Marshall Watson. In the end Marshall took 2nd, Luke 3rd and a very close 4th was Jarryd. The top 10 guys in this field were nose to tail across the whole weekend with some great times and some excellent racing.

Sportsman Light

With a field of 13 starters, it was a good battle across all the field. With not just battles up front but also good battles down the back. Up the front the battle was between Cian Fothergill (GKC), Brooke Leech and Morgan Haber. Morgan showed good pace all weekend, but come the final it was a great battle between Brooke and Cian across the whole 21 laps, it was Cian who came away with the win, Brooke was 2nd, Morgan 3rd, Luke Flynn (TKC) 4th and Brandon Rafter (TKC) 5th.

Sportsman Super Heavy

With 11 starters, it was a great race to watch. There were battles across the whole field, but it was Mark Muscat showing good speed for the first 2 heats and as Scott Simpson (GCKC, Aussie Champ) got the kart tuned in he started to find some speed and started the final in 2nd. In the final Mark took an early lead, with Scott and Brett Cruikshank close on his tail, but it was Scott Simpson (GCKC) who showed his class to take the win from a close Mark Muscat and Brett "my ribs hurt" Cruikshank (pinched rib vest) 3rd and a fast finishing Dale McDonnell (MKY) 4th.

Sportsman Over 40's



Come the final it was a 3 horse race (I mean kart race) between Steve Muscat, Scott Armstrong (TKC) and Shane Worbey, they exchanged positions over the 21 laps several times, but it was Scott Armstrong who came away with the win from Shane Worbey in 2nd, 3rd was Steve Muscat, 4th Robert Penfold and 5th was Craig Garioch.

Sportsman Heavy

Another big field of 17 starters and with some great racing across the field. Over the 4 races there were battles between the top 8, but it was Justin Garioch who showed his class across the weekend by taking the final easy from Bevan Garioch 2nd, Shane Leahy 3rd, Andrew Vella 4th, Kris Walton was 5th and Thomas Janusz was in 6th. These guys behind Justin battled, changed position all through the final and it was great to watch.

Senior National Light

With a good field of 10 karts and some great racing, it was a clear win to Shannon Price. Behind him there were some good battles between Jarryd Ebzery, Matthew Taylor (TKC), Todd Stevens and Morgan Haber. With Shannon taking the win, it was Jarryd 2nd, Matthew Taylor (TKC) 3rd and Todd Stevens was 4th.



**Junior National Heavy**

A good field of 8 starters, it was really a battle up front between Alistair Ingram and Jordan Page (GKC). The rest of the field had a good battle with each other, but it was a win to Alistair Ingram, 2nd was Jordan Page (GKC), a clear 3rd was Mitchell Rye and 4th was Luke Hamilton (TKC).


