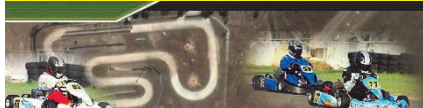

**Clubman Heavy**

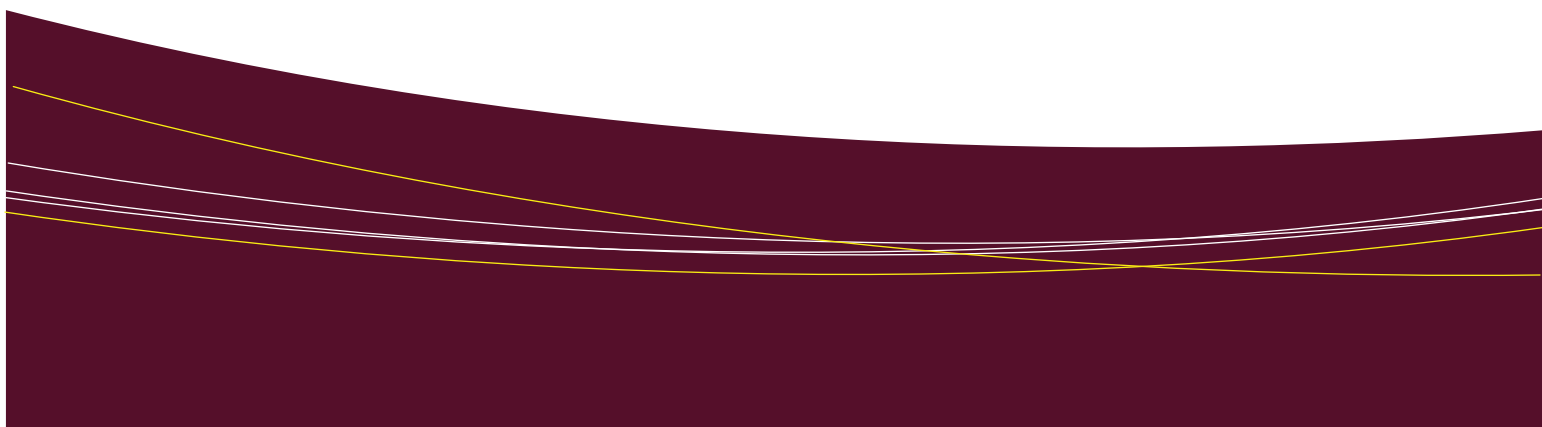
