



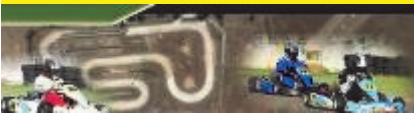
The AGM of Mackay and District Kart Club will be held at 7pm on Tuesday 12th October at Harrup Park Country Club in the Sportsman Room.

And what a great weekend of racing it was, with 79 entries there was some awesome racing done over the 2 days. It was good to see some clear sky's and fast times all weekend. Special thankyou to Levi Cameron and his band who played some tunes on the Saturday night.

Midgets

With a good field of 12 starters, it was the out of towners who took out the top positions and showed their class. It was won by Declan Bloye (TKC), 2nd was Jack Bussey (GKC) and 3rd went to Reily Bloye (TKC).

Rookies

With a field of 4 karters, it was a good battle between them all over the 2 days. Come the final it was a win to Jordan McGregor, 2nd was Jye Anderson and 3rd went to Matthew Want (CDKRC).

Junior National Light

With a field of 8 starters, there was a good battle across the top 4. It was a win to first time runner in this class Jake Downs, 2nd was Josh Smith (TKC), 3rd was Roland Legge.

Junior National Heavy

With a good field of 10 karters, it was a great battle between the top 2, Josh Smith and Hayden Schneider. The win went to Joshua Smith, 2nd was Hayden, 3rd went to Luke Jones and 4th was Nicholas Hamill.

Senior National Light

With a small field of 3 and only 2 starting the final. It was a win to Luke Caputo, 2nd was Todd Stevens and 3rd went to Jarryd Ebzery. It must be said that for only 3 racers, there were some excellent battles between them.



Senior National Heavy

With a great field of 12 karters, some great battles were done over the 3 rounds.
